SUNDAY MORNING SERMONS

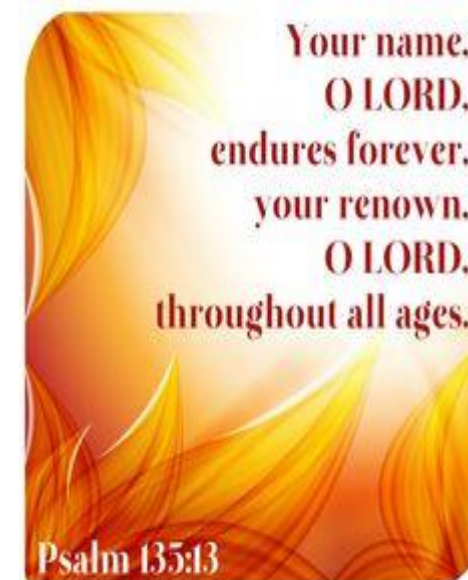
